We are excited to offer our 13th year of Summer Boot Camp for kids. Boot Camp is an exceptional discipleship program for students who will be entering grades K-8 in the Fall of 2019. It provides a fun, cost-effective, full day, 8 week program that addresses the whole child. Our overall objectives are:

- Academic: Literacy retention/improvement

- Social: Deepen relationships with other Christians and families of faith
- Physical/Extracurricular: Engage in Sports, Performing Arts and Fitness/Nutrition

Morning Assembly includes: Prayer, Praise & Worship, Camp Cadence and Fruit of the Spirit Awards

Morning Academics include: Math, Writing, Reading, Literacy Lab; Pre and post camp assessments

- Performing Arts: Dance, Drama, Vocal, Keyboards, Arts & Crafts
- Sports: Flag Football, Basketball, Soccer Kickball
- Personal/Spiritual Development: Christian Character, Life Skills/Leadership, Fruit of the Spirit

Job Summary

Lead and instruct children in a recreational sport activity or in the Arts. Bring in a spiritual piece while the children participate in an activity. Bringing a heart of joy and excitement for the sport you are leading. Provide supervisory responsibility for our student campers and ensuring their safety.

Specific Responsibilities

Leadership

1. Prepare and deliver the sport or activity to the students, set up in advance all equipment or supplies
2. Provide clear instructions and assist all children in participation
3. Encourage all children to get involved as a group, instructions may vary depending on age of children.
4. Pray daily for children in your group and camp staff.

Camp Safety/Discipline

1. Insure policies and practices maintain the health and safety of all students, staff and volunteers.
2. Be prepared to respond quickly and effectively in an emergency situation; including keeping safety materials on person at all times.
3. Complete escalation log on all disciplinary issues.
4. Provide a physically and emotionally safe learning environment for all campers.
5. Create ground rules and a responsibility process to help students own their actions.
6. Use the F.O.S. and Camp rules/policies to correct and redirect behaviors.
7. Insure that rooms or area used is cleaned and organized at end of each day

Communication

1. Open activity time in prayer with the students
2. Maintain open communications and have positive and professional relationship with students, camp staff, parents, instructors, volunteers, and MOBC staff. (able to give and receive feedback) **Eph. 4:29**
3. Maintain a positive and professional relationship with camp staff, parents, instructors, volunteers and MOBC staff.
