#### Organization

1. Planning, preparing and delivering all lessons to the students in classroom
2. Have a command of effective instruction including assessment and lesson planning

#### Communications

1. Maintain open communications and have a positive and professional relationship with students, camp staff, parents, instructors, volunteers and MOBC staff. ( able to give and receive feedback) **Eph. 4:29**
2. Attend weekly staff meetings with summer camp staff
3. Communicate daily with Recreational coordinator - sharing updates on student behavior and any classroom issues
4. Complete escalation log on all disciplinary issues.
5. Use the F.O.S. and Camp rules/policies to correct and redirect behaviors.
6. Communicate with the campers parents/guardian on any issues on a daily bases.

#### Leadership

1. Classroom behavior management
2. Maintaining good order and discipline in the classroom, while maintaining the health and safety of all students
