- Sports: Flag Football, Basketball, Soccer Kickball
- Personal/Spiritual Development: Christian Character, Life Skills/Leadership, Fruit of the Spirit

## Summer Boot Camp- Lead Teacher Job Description

### Job Summary

Support camp teachers in their classroom teaching and encouraging of students in the subjects of reading, writing and math. Give guidance to all teacher's to ensure that their management style is inclusive while helping all students excel in academics and providing a Spiritual safe an enriching environment.

Lead all teacher meetings once a week with a written agenda. Report weekly to Camp Director and Children's Ministry Director on items discussed during teacher meetings.

Encourage and assist teachers with new ways and styles to help students in their spiritual and social lives, bringing the importance of prayer into the classroom each day.

#### Organization

1. Prepare curriculum packets for pre and post assessments for all teachers
2. Time management to assist and observe all teachers in classrooms
3. Conduct pre and post assessment tests for all students
4. Monitor post tests for students ending camp attendance during the summer
5. Complete and deliver to Ministry Director all final test results assessment data

#### Communications

1. Maintain open communications and have a positive and professional relationship with students, camp staff, parents, instructors, volunteers and MOBC staff. ( able to give and receive feedback) **Eph. 4:29**
2. Lead weekly staff and prayer meetings with summer camp teachers
3. Communicate weekly with Camp Director and or Ministry Director of any classrooms observations or behaviors - successes and or challenges
4. Reviewing with teachers regarding lesson planning curriculum, extra learning tools to bring into the camp classrooms (creating group discussions on the fruits of the spirit)

#### Leadership

1. Supervision on the playground (recess time) Assisting teachers
2. Encouraging teachers in areas of professional strengths and spiritual guidance
3. Lead teacher staff training breakout session
4. Backup support for teacher break time
