We are excited to offer our 13<sup>th</sup> year of Summer Boot Camp for kids. Boot Camp is an exceptional discipleship program for students who will be entering grades K-8 in the Fall of 2019. It provides a fun, cost-effective, full day, 8 week program that addresses the whole child. Our overall objectives are:

4:00 - 4:30 Team Time

Morning Assembly includes: Prayer, Praise & Worship, Camp Cadence and Fruit of the Spirit Awards

Morning Academics include: Math, Writing, Reading, Literacy Lab; Pre and post camp assessments

- Performing Arts: Dance, Drama, Vocal, Keyboards, Arts & Crafts
- Sports: Flag Football, Basketball, Soccer Kickball
- Personal/Spiritual Development: Christian Character, Life Skills/Leadership, Fruit of the Spirit

### **Specific Responsibilities**

#### **Leadership**

1. Prepare and deliver the weekly team time lessons (spiritual and life) as scheduled to fellow team members.
2. Provide a high level of customer service (servanthood) at all times.
3. Project and maintain a positive image (on behalf of Mt Olivet).
4. Pray daily for children in your group, camp staff, and children's ministries.

#### **Camp Safety/Discipline**

1. Insure policies and practices maintain the health and safety of all students, staff and volunteers.
2. Be prepared to respond quickly and effectively in an emergency situation; including keeping safety materials on person at all times.
3. Complete escalation log on all disciplinary issues.
4. Provide a physically and emotionally safe learning environment for all campers.
5. Create ground rules and a responsibility process to help students own their actions.
6. Use the F.O.S. and Camp rules/policies to correct and redirect behaviors.
7. Help students evaluate their actions/behaviors and make good choices.
8. Insure all children are picked up by the appropriate parent/guardian before leaving
9. Insure that rooms are cleaned and organized at end of each day and deep cleaned on Fridays.

#### **Communication**

1. Maintain open communications and have positive and professional relationship with students, camp staff, parents, instructors, volunteers, and MOBC staff. (able to give and receive feedback) Eph. 4:29
2. Maintain a positive and professional relationship with camp staff, parents, instructors, volunteers and MOBC staff.
3. Attend daily staff meetings with Camp Director.
4. Communicate with the campers parents/guardian on any issues on a daily bases.
